Information about decommissioning of two boiling water reactors and common waste handling building at the Oskarshamn Nuclear Power Plant

Sweden would like to inform your country about the pending process regarding the decommissioning of reactor O1 and O2 at the Oskarshamn Nuclear Power Plant (NPP). Sweden has made the assessment that **the decommissioning of the two reactors does not entail any significant transboundary environmental impact** according to Article 3 in the Convention of Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context. This assessment is based on the nature of the environmental impact of the planned activities and the distance to neighboring countries (Approximately 250 - 300 km from the NPP to the territorial water borders of the closest of the informed countries). The enclosed document contains information in English about the planned decommissioning and its environmental impact.

The operator has submitted an application for a permit for dismantling and demolition of the reactors O1 and O2 to the permit authority, i.e. the Land and Environmental court of Växjö, 30 June 2017, together with an Environment Impact Statement (EIS).

The application as well as the EIS are at the moment reviewed regarding potential needs for supplement of additional information and data. As and then the permit authority deems the application to be complete, it will publicly announce the application and the EIS and make the documents available to the general public
