**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION ON THE PROPOSED ACTIVITY –  
DISMANTLING AND DECONTAMINATION OF EQUIPMENT OF UNITS A-2 AND V-2  
OF IGNALINA NUCLEAR POWER PLANT**

We would like to thank you for the opinion regarding transboundary environmental impact assessment (hereinafter referred to as EIA) for the proposed activity – Dismantling and Decontamination of Units A-2 and V-2 of Ignalina Nuclear Power Plant (hereinafter referred to as INPP), which is a subproject within the overall INPP decommissioning megaproject, as regulated by the Law on the Ignalina Nuclear Power Plant Decommissioning of the Republic of Lithuania, No. XII-914.

As requested by your letter No. 5-01/230 dated 12 March, 2020 and your e-mail letter dated 27 March, 2020, hereby we submit supplementary information regarding the EIA of the proposed activity: an extended summary of the EIA report and a presentation on the decommissioning process of INPP.

In view of your request to carry out transboundary environmental impact assessment we ask you to provide the enclosed information to relevant authorities and the public of the Republic of Latvia, and to inform us about the preferred method of expert consultations: by exchange of letters or by organizing expert meetings.
